Developing entrepreneurial abilities paves the way to boldly create new enterprises that step up to these challenges.

The objective of this program is to encourage and empower AUA students and graduates to excel at developing solutions to regional and global challenges. Researching global issues and determining where they can influence sustainability and change, students are encouraged to enhance their entrepreneurial skills to develop impactful business solutions.

By joining this program hosted by the International Innovation Center of Tsinghua University, Shanghai (IICTUS), students will acquire in-depth knowledge of the dynamic field of entrepreneurship. The various activities will offer students the opportunity to interact with creative and motivating individuals from all across the AUA community.

Components

The program consists of two parts: Lectures and the Entrepreneurship Competition. **Please note,** attending lectures is a prerequisite for participating in the Entrepreneurship Competition.

I. Lectures

In the age of unprecedented global and technological transformation, innovations contribute to the success of enterprises. During the lectures, speakers will share their personal entrepreneurial experiences of navigating future business uncertainty. Students will learn the basic concepts of successful entrepreneurship, "outside of the box" thinking, and prepare for their roles and responsibilities as part of the workforce of the future.

Students will learn key entrepreneurial concepts through lectures, experiential learning, videos and interaction with successful entrepreneurs.

II. Entrepreneurship Competition

The Entrepreneurship Competition encourages students to take direct control of their learning experience extending well beyond the bounds of the school day. Students will be inspired to transform from the mindset of "student" to that of entrepreneurial problem-solvers, addressing social, scientific and societal issues through creativity and critical thinking.

The competition will be held during the last week of the program. Registered participants shall prepare a Business Plan and make a 15-minute presentation during the online competition. The competition theme will be announced during the program kick-off.

Professionals from industry, research and academia shall be invited as judges to select the awards for outstanding projects based on social value, project creativity, technological innovation, and project completion. This unique competition gives students direct exposure to industry experts, corporations, investors and universities. Students will have the opportunity to meet like-minded people from all over the world and build a level of entrepreneurship that will benefit them for years to come.

Benefits

All participants will earn a course certificate after the program. The top 10 winners of the Entrepreneurship Competition will be awarded a competition certificate and up to 1500 USD travel reimbursement to Shanghai to join events hosted by IICTUS when borders open (Provisionally scheduled for summer 2021).
